

**Salt Lake County Sanitation District
Private Road Agreement**

I, _____ as the property owner (hereafter "owner") at

_____, hereby request curbside refuse and recycling collection services from Salt Lake County Sanitation Special Service District No. 1 for the resident residing adjacent to a private road.

1. The Salt Lake County Sanitation District (hereafter "District") hereby agrees to provide curbside refuse and recycling collection services to the owner pursuant to the conditions set out in this agreement.

2. The owner agrees to provide timely snow removal and adequate road maintenance to allow District refuse and recycling trucks adequate accessibility and to minimize backing or unsafe maneuvers by the trucks. If road conditions are such that District trucks cannot safely negotiate the roadway, owner agrees to place refuse and recycling cans at the nearest public access. Owner acknowledges that road conditions may result in the inability of the District to collect owner's refuse or recycling and owner agrees to hold the District harmless in such an event.

3. This form serves as my acknowledgment releasing Sanitation Special Service District No. 1, its employees or agents, from any liability for damages to road surfaces, roadway shoulders, bridges, property, overhanging trees or other landscaping caused by Sanitation District equipment.

4. The owner acknowledges that providing special refuse and recycling collection services under this agreement shall in no way obligate the Salt Lake County Public Works Department to provide road maintenance or repair, snow removal or other services to the private road.

5. Private Road Requirements:

- 5.1 100% of residents on the private road must agree to and sign the agreement before collection begins.
- 5.2 Grades, banks, and curves must be of a nature to permit safe and efficient operations.
- 5.3 The road must provide 14.5 feet width and 14.5 feet height clearance.
- 5.4 The road must have ample turn-arounds sufficient in size to accommodate regular District equipment or a straight-through exit. District drivers cannot use private driveways for turn-arounds. The road must have enough space in the turn-around to minimize the need for backing up. Drivers will only back up once per road and not for an extended distance. Drivers will never back out of a private road onto a public street or other road.
- 5.5 Roads must be regularly maintained, have snow removed, and have adequate surfaces able to handle heavy equipment without causing damage to the District equipment.
- 5.6 Trees, shrubs, and landscaping must be trimmed to 14.5 feet above road surface.
- 5.7 The District will determine can placement. Garbage and recycle cans will not be placed under any overhanging objects including, but not limited to, trees and basketball hoops.
- 5.8 Garbage cans and recycle cans will be properly placed 4 feet apart and 4 feet away from fences, walls, trees, and cars.
- 5.9 Cars will be parked off the street so as not to obstruct District equipment.
